Quick Start Guide

1. Charge battery using USB cable until **LED#3** stop blinking and is steady.
2. **POWER ON:** Long press **Control 4**
3. Connect unit to Computer via USB cable. Verify that computer recognizes unit as "UWATER". Upload songs/audio files/audio books (see instructions page 7).
4. Select play mode **NORMAL** or **SHUFFLE** (long pressing **Controls 6 or 7**)
5. Connect Earphones. Adjust Volume.
6. Play/Pause using **Control 4**
7. Move Forward/backward using **Controls 5, 7**
8. **POWER OFF:** Long press **Control 4**
9. **RESET:** press **Control 4** 10 seconds

LED Control Panel

LED 1:

Blinking: Shuffle mode, Play

Steady: Shuffle mode, Pause

LED 2:

Blinking: Normal mode, Play

Steady: Normal mode, Pause

LED 3:

Double Blinking: Low Battery Indication

Blinking: Unit is being charged

Steady: Unit is fully charged

All LED's blinking: No audio file uploaded.

Control Functions Chart

4 ON/OFF - Long Press

Pause/Play - Short Press

RESET - Press 10 seconds

5 Next File - Short Press

Fast Forward - Long Press

6 Volume Down - Repeat Short Press

NORMAL Mode - Long Press

Control Functions Chart, Continued

7 Previous File - Short Press

Fast Rewind - Long Press

8 Volume Up - Repeat Short Press

SHUFFLE MODE - Long Press

Long Press: Press for 3-4 seconds

Short Press: Press momentarily then release.

Recharging the Battery:

- To recharge the battery via USB port of your PC, simply connect the player using the USB cable to your PC.
- To recharge the battery using the USB charger (optional), simply connect the player to the charger using the USB cable, then connect the charger to the power supply.

*NOTE: When disconnected from the USB port after recharging or file uploading, the player switches off automatically.

OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR WINDOWS

Copying MP3 Files from PC to the MP3 Player:

- Connect the player to the USB port of your PC using the USB cable.
- A "" icon appears at the bottom right of the Tool Bar. A "Removable Disk" icon also appears in "My Computer".
- Use the File Manager function to copy files into the player.
- Then double-click the "" icon at the right bottom of the Tool Bar to disable the "Removable Disk". When the "This Disk Has Been Disabled Successfully" dialog box appears, disconnect the player from the USB port.

How to Download from iTunes

1. Select songs from your iTunes music library that you want to download. (You can hold the CTRL button down on your keyboard for multiple tracks.)
2. Using your mouse, simply drag and drop the music selected into the window of your Player.
3. The status light on Player will flash red as the songs are being downloaded.

How To Convert Other Formats to MP3 Format using iTunes

1. Select songs from your library that you want converted to MP3 format by highlighting them. (For multiple songs, hold the CTRL button on your keyboard and select songs using your mouse.)
2. Locate the Advanced tab on the iTunes menu bar.
3. In the Advanced drop down menu, choose Convert Selection(s) to MP3.
4. iTunes will now begin creating copy of the songs you selected in MP3 format. (You may now delete the original version of songs you selected to convert, if you choose. The new MP3 formatted songs can now be dragged and dropped into your Player.)
5. Make sure both iTunes and your Player window are open (double click on My Computer and locate the drive that reads "Removable Storage Device" or UWater Player).
6. Once you have both iTunes and the player window open, minimize each window so that you have equal boxes side by side.
7. Follow steps 1-3 "How To Download From iTunes" above.

OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAC USERS

Copying MP3 Files from PC to the MP3 Player:

- Connect the player to the USB port of your Mac book using the USB cable.
- A new folder appears on the desktop of your screen with the name of your device.
- Use the File Manager function to copy files into the player.
- Eject the device by clicking on the Eject Icon (▲) next to the name of the device in the Finder Window on the left side.

How to Download from iTunes

1. Select songs from your iTunes music library that you want to download. (You can hold the Command button down on your keyboard for multiple tracks OR you may select the first song and then select the last song holding shift to select the entire songs list).
2. Using your mouse, simply drag and drop the music selected into the window of your Player on the desktop.
3. The status light on Player will flash red as the songs are being downloaded.

How To Convert Other Formats to MP3 Format using iTunes

1. Select songs from your library that you want converted to MP3 format by highlighting them. (For multiple songs, hold the Command button on your keyboard and select songs using your mouse.)
2. Locate the Advanced tab on the iTunes menu bar.
3. In the Advanced drop down menu, choose Convert Selection(s) to MP3.
4. iTunes will now begin creating copy of the songs you selected in MP3 format. (You may now delete the original version of songs you selected to convert, if you choose. The new MP3 formatted songs can now be dragged and dropped into your Player.)
5. Make sure both iTunes and your Player window are open (You may find this folder on the desktop or in the Finder on the left side)
6. Follow steps 1-3 "How To Download From iTunes" above.

How to Download Audio Books:

Audio books must be in MP3 format. Contact audio book provider for specific instructions.

Trouble Shooting

I can't turn on my Player/Tuner.

Make sure unit is fully charged. Then long-press Control #4.

Player is not recognized by my Computer.

Make sure USB Cable is properly connected to Player and Computer and Player is charged.

There is no sound while Player is ON and PLAY Control is activated.

Make sure Player is charged and audio files (songs, audio books) were downloaded. Make sure earphones are properly connected and VOLUME + Control is adjusted.

Sound was lost or weakened while swimming.

Probably water reached over eartips into your ear canals blocking sound. Improve fitting eartips or use larger eartips (try use the triple action eartips while lap swimming).
